### **Payment of subscriptions by PayPal**

To assist members to pay their subscription, a PayPal account has been established. Members wishing to pay by this method can do so by following these steps:

1. Set up a PayPal account by going to [www.paypal.com](http://www.paypal.com)
2. Log in to your account
3. Choose the Send Money tab
4. The recipient's email address is ***treasurer@iaop.com***
5. The amount payable is ***40 GB Pounds*** per two years
6. Please enter ***IAOP subscription*** in the Email Subject line to assist in processing your payment
7. Please keep a record of your payment as a receipt for tax purposes.
