



**Michael D. Rohrer, D.D.S., M.S.**

Professor Michael Rohrer is Professor and Director of the Division of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology at the University of Minnesota. Previous to his joining the University of Minnesota in 2000, he was a Presidential Professor at the University of Oklahoma Colleges of Dentistry and Medicine. He is a Diplomate and past president of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology. Professor Rohrer served for a number of years as the Consultant in Pathology to the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. He is a Fellow and immediate past president of the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology and a Fellow of the American College of Dentists. Professor Rohrer is a charter member of the International Association of Oral Pathologists.

Professor Rohrer received his undergraduate and dental degrees from the University of Michigan as well as the Master of Science in Oral Pathology following service in the Army and several years in general practice. He has four patents in the field of sterilization by microwaves, has published over 90 research articles and has received 52 research grants and contracts. Professor Rohrer has spent 2 sabbatical leaves with Prof. Dr. (mult.) Karl Donath at the University of Hamburg. For the last 21 years he has been very active in research in dental implants and bone substitutes with collaborations throughout the U.S.A. and the world.

Professor Rohrer is the Director of the University of Minnesota Oral Pathology Laboratories. Besides having an active surgical oral pathology practice, he has maintained an active clinical oral pathology practice.
